



There are three stages known as 'waves' that outline the provision we provide for our pupils

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| <b>Wave 1 - Universal</b>  | <b>Wave 1</b> is the effective inclusion of all pupils through high quality teaching and learning. All teachers use inclusive strategies such as Kagan collaborative learning structures, dyslexia friendly approaches, sensory breaks and Word Aware.   |
| <b>Wave 2 - Targeted</b>   | <b>Wave 2</b> includes specific, additional and time-limited interventions provided for some pupils who need help to accelerate their progress to enable them to work at or above age-related expectations. Wave 2 interventions are often targeted at a group of pupils with similar needs.                   |
| <b>Wave 3 - Specialist</b> | <b>Wave 3</b> is targeted provision for a minority of pupils where it is necessary to provide highly tailored interventions to accelerate progress or to enable children to achieve their potential. This may include one to one or specialist support from outside agencies or an education health care plan. |
